

Parent Checklist: Questions & What to Look For

1 Does this system fit my child's learning style?

👉 *Look for:* Systems that match how your child learns best. For example, CBG can be great for hands-on learners or kids who need more time. ESNU works well for younger kids where effort and behavior matter most.

2 How does it align with their college or career plans?

👉 *Look for:* Systems that won't create surprises at college application time. In my opinion, A–F or hybrid systems are safer if your child's aiming for competitive colleges. But Pass/Fail can be fine for electives or tough courses if explained in transcripts.

3 Is the school trained in this system?

👉 *Look for:* Schools that provide clear rubrics, feedback, and support. I'd recommend asking for examples of report cards or progress updates — just to see how well it's implemented.
